## **“Housing and cleaning up information at Palisades:**

The City has already initiated Phase 1 of the cleanup process. This phase involves the removal of hazardous debris and the clearing of public areas to ensure safety and facilitate further recovery efforts.

Phase 2 of the cleanup requires the active participation of property owners. This phase focuses on the removal of debris from private properties, and it is essential for all affected owners to sign up for this free service by March 30th. Whether you are planning to rebuild your home or considering selling your land, it is in your best interest to take advantage of this opportunity. By signing up for the free cleanup, you can ensure your property is safe and ready for future use.

We understand that many of you may have sustained homes that, unfortunately, will remain uninhabitable for up to six months due to ongoing cleanup, electricity issues, and hazardous safety conditions. During this period, to help you maintain a safer and healthier environment, the city is offering free air purifiers. If you are in need of an air purifier, please reach out to the city for assistance. They will bring them to your property and will remove them once you are done.

For those who may not want to undertake elaborate construction, there are companies that build prefab homes, similar to the community close to Paradise Cove. With this option, you can simply select your kitchen and bathroom preferences, and they will build a prefab home on your lot in a short period of time. Additionally, there are real estate agents working to maintain the value and integrity of the Palisades community by facilitating sales within the community. They can assist those who wish to leave Palisades or transition to different parts of the city. If these are options that the community is interested in learning more about, I have to ask for some experts to come and give a presentation as to what these options are in detail.

Please take a moment to sign up for Phase 2 cleanup by visiting the city's designated website or contacting the recovery team directly. If you have any questions or need assistance with the

sign-up process, acquiring an air purifier, obtaining essential supplies, or exploring housing options, do not hesitate to reach out.

Regarding long-term leases, rental has come to Zillow or Redfin websites, there are also off market options but there needs to be an agent to guide you on those that have currently been leased. However, in the next month or so, new properties are expected to become available. If we can gather information on the specific areas you are interested in and type of rentals, it might help narrow down the options and expedite finding suitable housing.”

### **Bedding:**
